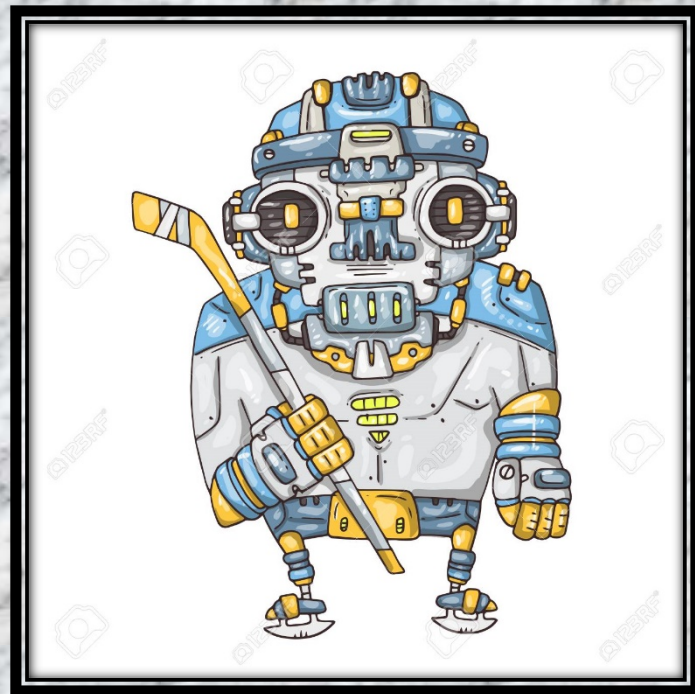


HWSS HOCKEY TRY-OUTS

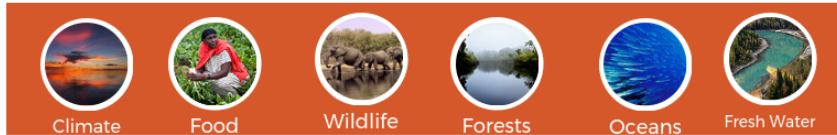

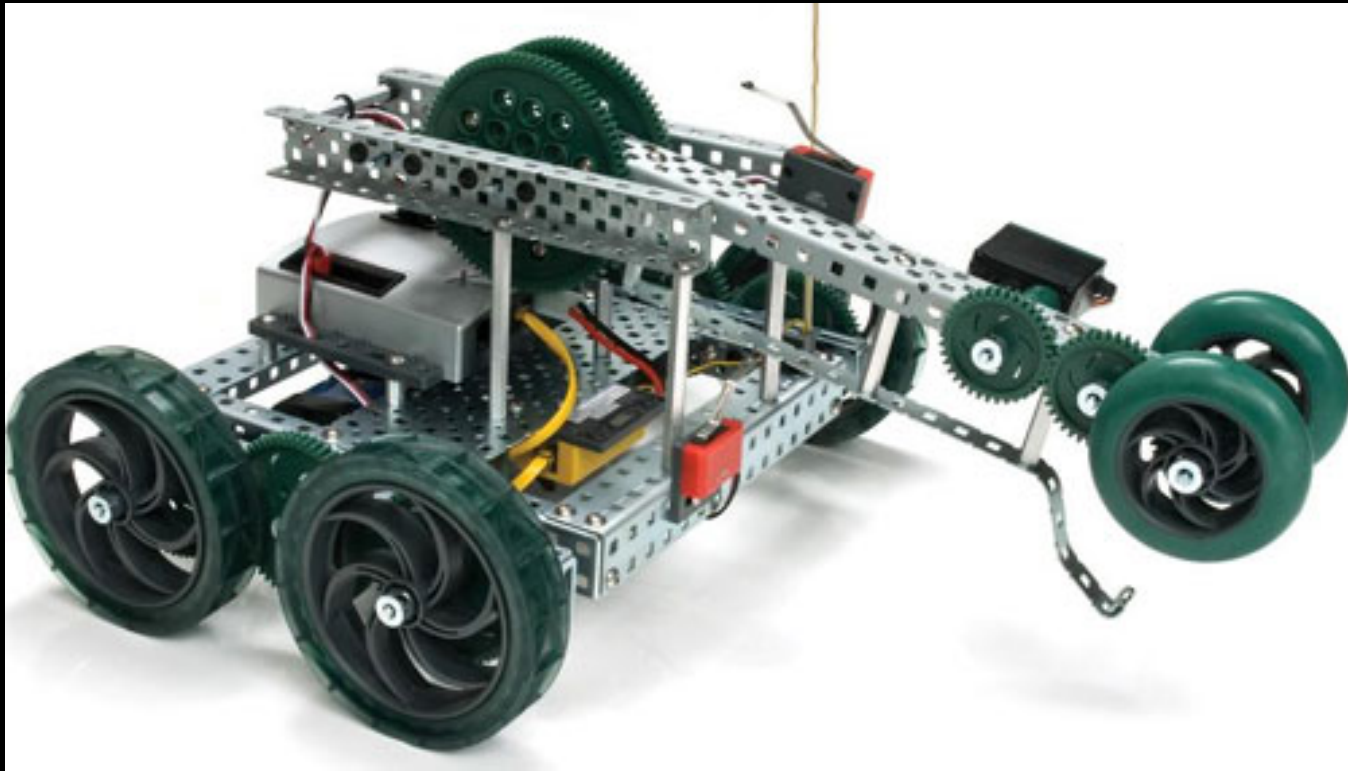

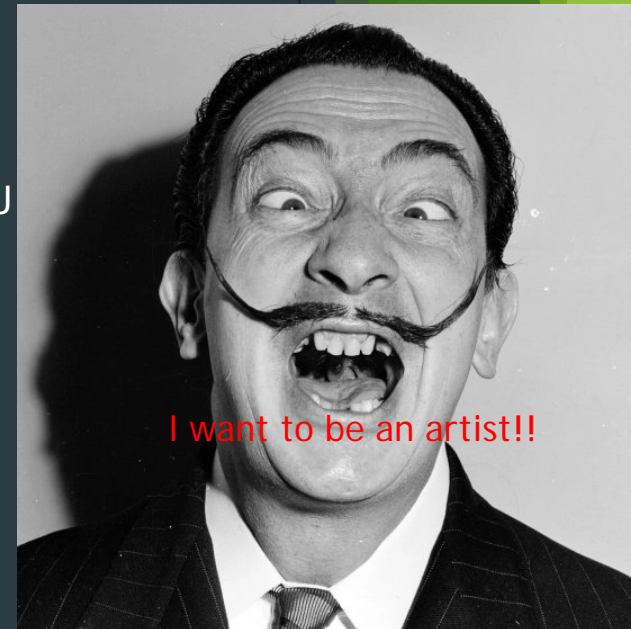
