



Please provide UBC with your Personal Education Number (PEN) and order a transcript for UBC via StudentTranscripts.gov.bc.ca by December 1 (if you want to be considered for a Presidential Scholars Award or early admission, or if you are applying for the UBC Centennial Scholars Entrance Award) or by January 31 (in all other cases). When ordering your transcript, select "send my transcript now and allow this Post-Secondary Institution to request transcript updates" and choose the default date (one year from the date of your order) so that we can receive your interim and final grades continuously.


