- Attendance- Have you attended 90% of the time?

Choose Send Option

Students can choose how they want to send their transcript to the post-secondary institutions they have selected; note the delivery method is dependent on the Post-Secondary Institution.

Currently the defaults are set to:

- NEW Send my transcript now and allow this Post
 Secondary Institution to request transcript updates until the date specified below: XML transcript is sent immediately to PSI for downloading and updates can be requested by the PSI until the date shown.
- Send interim and final marks when they are available: interim marks are sent electronically in May and final marks are sent electronically in July. This option will only be displayed for current students and is not available to former students.
- <u>Send final marks when they are available</u>: displayed when the post-secondary institution only receives printed copies of transcripts; your final marks will be mailed in July
