- You are a mature and motivated learner <u>and</u>
- You potentially have a skill set superior to an introductory level language course due to previous course work either through school or online <u>and/or</u>
- You have been/are in a home environment or community where you regularly <u>speak, read and</u>
 write in one of these languages
