Get Started

StudentTranscripts service (STS) - Province of British Columbia (gov.bc.ca)

- The StudentTranscripts Service is an online self-serve tool that current and former B.C. K-12 students can use to:
 - •View and order secondary school transcripts
 - •Send their secondary school transcript to post-secondary institutions (colleges and universities)
 - •Order their graduation certificate (if graduated)
 - •View their B.C. Scholarship awards
 - •View their provincial exam or graduation asse

The StudentTranscripts Service can be found on the Ministry of Education and Child Care Transcripts and Certificates web page, <u>StudentTranscripts</u>. To access the STs FIRST you will need a Basic BCeID.

Important Information for Students

- Students must register for a BC Government account, a BCeID before accessing the StudentTranscript Service.
- Current students receive 25 free transcripts for distribution
- Students are responsible for ensuring transcript accuracy prior to transmission to post-secondary

institutions

What we need from Grade 12 Students:

- 1. Today and tomorrow @ LUNCH: Pick up your Unofficial School Transcript from the counsellors in the Grand hall
- 2. Create BCeID and Login to the **STUDENT TRANSCRIPT SERVICES** (if you need help, refer to the previous slides)
- **3.** <u>Compare</u> your School Unofficial Transcript (that you received from us) to your on-line transcript that you access using your BCeID.
- 4. If there are any <u>errors</u> or things that don't seem right to you, you MUST print off the Ministry Transcript and hand both transcripts into your counsellor ASAP with a written explanation of the error.

BOTH transcripts should match! If they don't, you need to let us know so we can help fix it!

So, first, let's make sure you graduate!



A Quick Review

Students must earn at least 80 course credits and complete the Provincial Graduation Assessments in numeracy and literacy to graduate. Find full details about <u>requirements for the B.C. Certificate of Graduation</u>.
