Ways Teachers Can Support	<p>Teacher proximity during transitions</p> <p>Teams to discuss best method for students to transition from class to class</p> <p>Model appropriate movement through hallways</p>	<p>Teachers supervise students directly in all settings.</p> <p>Teachers will close their classroom doors as they leave for nut break</p> <p>Teachers will move promptly at warning bells to their classrooms to greet students</p>	<p>Follow SLC initiative for team based clean up</p> <p>Active supervision</p> <p>Assigned supervision areas</p>		<p>Students under direct supervision when using computer labs</p>	<p>Lead students to and from assembly</p> <p>Review specific expectations before each type of assembly prior to leaving</p>	<p>Supervise hallways outside the change rooms</p>	<p>Clarify expectations prior to going</p> <p>Have a cell phone and leave contact numbers</p> <p>Leave car/bus assignments in the office</p>		<p>We are responsible for all learners in our school therefore- Staff will provide reminders, role model and enforce expectations using natural and logical consequences</p>
