- 1. Ms. Birnie back full time
- 2. District developed online registration program- Programs of Choice French Immersion, Montessori, Mandarin, and Reggio are going online at this point. All families who wish to register a child for French Immersion kindergarten for Sept. 2018 must register online. Siblings must still be registered at same time as other students as new program does not immediately delineate siblings from new students! More information will be published to families posted on school and district websites and through newspaper ads in the local papers.
- 3. New Contract for Teachers-supreme court ruling has changed things in the province. We now have more teachers overall at the school, many from other districts with varying ranges of experience (6-20yrs).
