Principals Report - Dennis Shannon:

- FamilySmart is a 20-year-old organization which provides peer support, information, and mentorship to families of child, youth or young adult (0-24+) with mental health and/or substance use challenges. - All services are free. No waitlist. No referral needed.
- Parents-In-Residence are parents and caregivers with lived experience.
