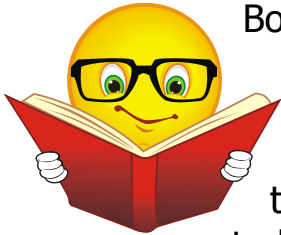

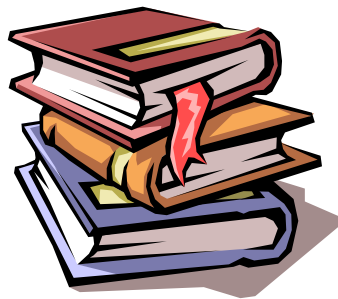

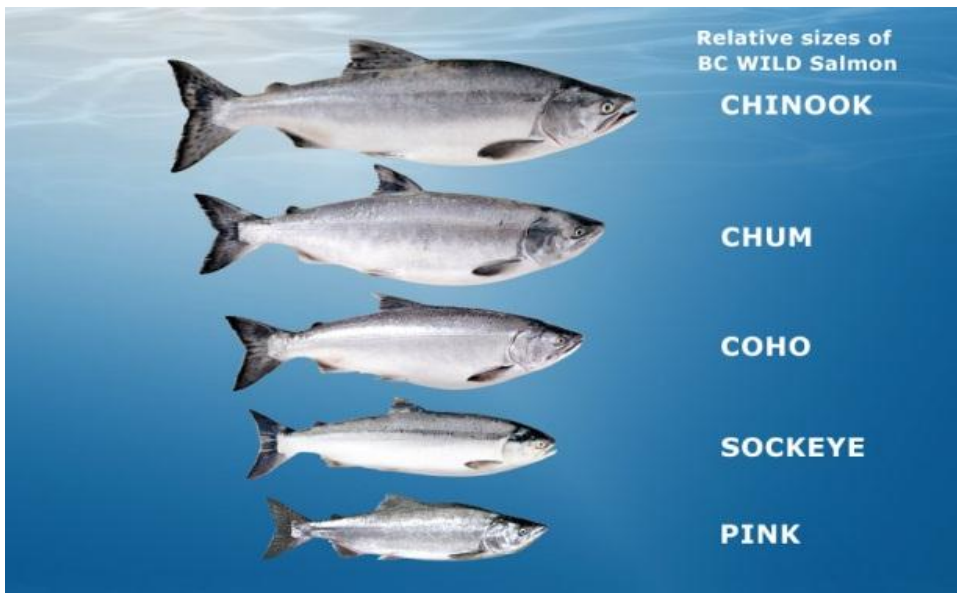
A Successful Book Fair!
