Here are a few "short and sweet: pieces of info for you to keep you up to speed with upcoming events:

- Students in Classes: Students are now in their core classes and explorations classes have just started. Thanks for your patience. This year has been a bit more challenging as we have had to juggle our organization to accommodate the increase in our enrollment and keep the class size and composition regulations in balance. As a result, we were given additional staffing for an extra Gr. 6/7 division and spent the last week creating this division and adjusting the explorations classes. Enrollment is roughly 630 students.

- Band, Clubs and Athletics: We will be slowly starting up these programs in October and will send out information to you in the coming weeks.
- **Pro- D Day:** The first Pro-D Day is this Friday, **September 24th.** There is no school for students. The staff will be involved in workshops, setting goals for the coming school year and preparing for our literacy assessments for students.
- Truth and Reconciliation National Holiday: September 30<sup>th</sup>: A reminder that this new holiday is next Thursday, September 30<sup>th</sup> and schools are closed for the observance of those impacted by the residential school system.
