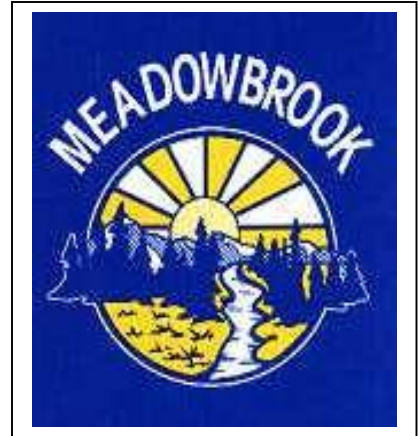


# Meadowbrook News

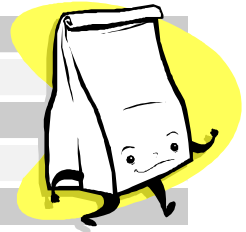
