RHYTHMIC GYMNASTICS

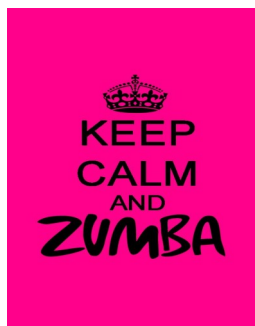
