- a. Racially Motivated Incident
 - Two Minnekhada students were racially offensive online towards a student in a different district.
 - ii. The school and district take such matters seriously and the situation is being addressed using established protocols.
 - iii. Staff have been debriefed, an email was sent to all parents, and teachers are having conversations with their classes.
 - iv. A number of initiatives were undertaken in February which is both Kindness Month and Black History Month and key messages are taught throughout the year.
 - v. We are committed to ensuring the safety and well-being of all students.

b. COVID Situation

 The school worked closely with Fraser Health, navigating their complex process and closely following their protocols which resulted in there not being any spread between classrooms.
