REPORTS:

Principal's Report: Pam Becker

- Screen share tour of the new school.
- June 1st return. Strange end to the school year. Approx. 1/3 students returning which is comparable to the province. Ms Lauzon is the health and safety lead and this morning's back-to-school worked great. Staff very involved and supportive. Difficult situation that ended up going well. Did a tour this morning with the kids. Will be repeated with each of the four groups. Teachers online, supporting kids in class, and getting outside.
- Enrollment for Sept substantial increase for the coming school year. 24 divisions up by 3 divisions and totalling nearly 600 students. Therefore, the new school is effectively full.
- June progress reports email coming out this coming week from teachers. The focus this term during remote learning has been on literacy, numeracy, and social/emotional. Will see correspondence regarding parent involvement and feedback from parents regarding their progress.
- Grade 6s incoming grade 6 for a morning wasn't able to go ahead. Therefore, working on a video tour of the school (Mr Wiebe), each exploration teacher will talk about their area and each team leader has taken on a key talking point. Then a tour of the school and also answering questions from feeder grade 5s.
- Grade 8 leaving ceremony cancelled. To celebrate grade 8s a video being prepared with photos and statements from leavers. Will be shared in June with all grade 8 leavers.
- Big thank you to this year's PAC and encourage incoming Grade 6s to join PAC.

Treasurer: Stacy Gokool

- Report attached.
- New deposits were from just prior to Covid. \$125 from TCBY. Pizza day was \$320.70. Freezies and Dilly Bars was \$301.80.
- Total profit this year was \$2,795.08.
- Closing balance \$6,303.59 in the General Account.
- Gaming account zero movement as we can't spend anything during the pandemic.
- \$12,536.52 usually spent on water slide busses, grade 8 leaving, etc.
- Applied for next year's gaming grant but have not heard back yet.
- We can roll over this year's money into next year's gaming account. Won't infringe upon next year's gaming grant.
- Gaming grant from casinos etc. is unknown so they will know more in September.
- Had money set aside for teacher appreciation. Q to Pam re: gift cards for teachers? No lunches or buffets possible. Any suggestions? Perhaps do it in the Fall instead? Staff are there four days a week. Jamie – Terry fox carrying through to Sept and Cedar Dr buying gift cards so it is up to PAC. Shannon/Gabi would rather do it now.

- Just under 50 staff. Budget for staff appreciation is normally \$400. That would only work out to be about \$10 pp. Do we want to increase budget? Discussion on options and whether we can up the budget.
- Andrea motioned a \$10 GC pp to say thank you to the staff. Nicole seconded.
- Corrina motioned a \$15 GC pp, and Stacey seconded.
- \$15 gift card per teacher wins 7-4.
- Stacey offered to organize.
- Question about what ideas for the new school to spend the budget on. Pam happy to wait till Sept and submit a list then. By that time, we will have more info as to what our gaming funds will be.
- Wood etc. for outdoor planters on the patio might be a contribution. None of that will happen now. Anything community oriented comes out of gaming account.
- Any other questions about treasurer's report? No.
