- Next year's enrollment projection is 450 students, 12
 Neighbourhood, 2 Montessori, 5 Late French Immersion not certain for sure, depends on staffing, but down from 480.
- **Shoutout to Christine** for shopping weekly for the lunch program. It's very helpful and the need is growing.
- Yearbook due end of the month.
 - Yearbooks for those who didn't purchase one we have in the past but we didn't put it in the budget.
 Some families choose not to and some cannot manage but we do try our best to.
- April 23rd is district professional day. Workshop on equality. Focus is on indigineous education - district virtual workshop and then break out as school staff.
- Before spring break hit we further reinforced expectations
 with safety measures (ie hand hygiene, distancing etc.) and
 when we came back, we've been even more on around
 hands to self, separation, staying on the right side of the
 hall. Mask mandate changed for them. It used to be they
 could take off their masks for a break at their desk but now

- everyone needs to be with a mask unless they are eating. Even that has changed as everyone must be seated and facing forward.
- Grade 8s leaving planning has started. What's unknown is what will June look like for us? Plans are to only be in the class cohorts. Right now it is looking like it'll be done class by class and having time with them through the courtyard with a balloon arch. We're trying to see how we can make it special for them. In order to do this the current plan will be the day of pick up report card (after the last day of school) Hopefully, more substantial than last year. Asking the student govt, what would be appreciated?

Some grade 8s worried about high school. No parents for now for the grade 8s leaving. Class event only.

Can it be on teams to see some friends? - still early planning stages. Last year there were videos.

If things change, we will go with the changes. Our goal is to make it as normal as possible. Plan for the worse, hope for the best.

- Outside equipment getting broken some pickleball racquet broke easily; therefore, not eager to replace. Looking for durable equipment. We are making sure the equipment is being taken cared of, sanitized, put away. Teaching the kids to take care of the equipment and keeping it in good condition.
 Sometimes the ball does go on the roof but the vast majority doing the right thing and some of course doing deliberately. It's a balance. Some kids are struggling especially with the pandemic, either unstable at home, financially, or mental health, so sometimes we need to let certain things go.
