- Mental Health Resources Presentation Sabine presented what DPAC had presented in the Nov. DPAC meeting
 - What Monty is doing in relation to the presentation:
 - Every class has a mood meter a tool used after they have the social emotional vocabulary. Fridays, Allie Deip does a safety tip every morning - for example on self compassion, ways of thinking etc.
 - Inclusive and welcoming to all
 - Individual class reviews who are some kids they are concerned about (Identifying)
 - As a school workshop on mental health/wellbeing for the staff.
 Coming up will be a bingo (ie...going for a walk). What are simple things staff can do to take care of themselves?
 - Multi step approach. Always starting with prevention, education otherwise there will be more intervention.
 - Have SFL leaders

- Counsellor, youth worker and Indegionous youth worker will run social skill groups - this year is smaller because of covid
- Leadership group
- Family Smart Presentation families who have young people struggling
 with mental health issues on how to navigate the system. Can be hard on
 families. This is families helping families. Started webinars on their
