### 11. Administration Report - Mrs. Husband

- a. Every year we review the Code of conduct. There are a few changes to the statement of purpose for next year as follows:
  - 1. To add: to assist all members of our school community to become self-aware and open to learning about inequities in our society, being an ally, and privilege.
  - 2. Recommended to update all binary gender (he/she) to student.
  - 3. The current language around cell phones "are to be stored in lockers between 845am-3pm, unless used under the supervision of a teacher and for an educational or medical reason (technology for learning). Phones will be collected if in use and securely stored until 3pm."
    Purposed language "Cell phones are to be stored in lockers upon arrival inside the school in the morning to 3pm. Students can access their phones at 3pm, unless used........"
    Some students arrive early and instead of being on their phones in the school, it could be a time for them to interact with other students and staff.
