The next two weeks promise to be as busy as ever with many activities scheduled, taking us into the break. March is a short month here at school with the two week Spring Break in the second half.

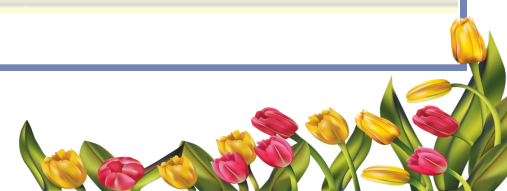
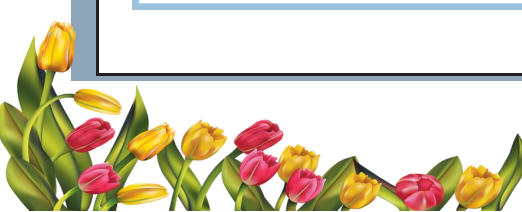
I hope families enjoy a relaxing Spring Break with friends and family and that students come back refreshed and ready for our final term and the sprint towards June.
