REGISTRATION FOR THE 2024-25 SCHOOL YEAR

Registration processes for the 2024-25 school year begin right after the winter break!

The *Cross Catchment Application Process* (all grades) will be held from January 11 -January 17th. Please note that students in Grade 5 are assigned to their catchment area school (see school locator tool on District website) and not according to the elementary school they currently attend. Please refer to the details on the District website for questions pertaining to sibling status.

The application process for Programs of Choice: **Montessori**, **Mandarin Bilingual**, **Reggio and French Immersion** will occur from **January 11-January 17th**, **2024**. IF YOU ARE INTERESTED IN APPLYING TO HAVE YOUR CHILD ATTEND A PROGRAM OF CHOICE, please consider viewing the online informational video presentations located on our District website.

Kindergarten Registration will be held between **February 6^{th} - 8^{th} 2024**, using the online forms that will be housed on school websites. Only students who are five years of age on or before December 31, 2024, are eligible to enroll for September 2024.
