Place: Como Lake Middle School - 1121 King Albert Ave.

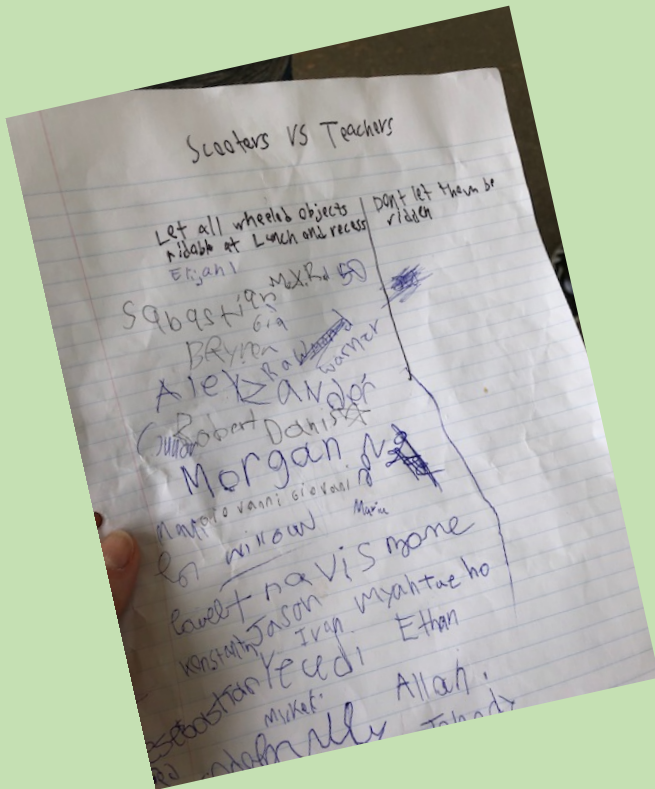
