We have been working with our Intermediate classes on Reading, here's some of the reading goals we'll be working on:

- Students need to answer in complete sentences.
- Students need to read the question in full or carefully, many are only answering part of the question or read it quickly and assume what it says.
- Many/most are using background knowledge (sometimes correct sometimes not) and not using the text in their answer or to support their answers.



We had an assembly today with a focus on Plastics in the Ocean. The students were asked to share one thing they learned with an adult at home.

We are into week two of four swimming lessons this week. We felt good about the level of lessons the students were exposed to and the overall organization went smoothly.

Really fun to watch the students who were challenged outside of their classroom.

We had an eventful lunch hour last Friday as 20 high school students from Heritage Woods Secondary came to break bread with 25 of our students. We randomly chose the students and we are hoping to continue this initiative on a monthly basis. This fit nicely with our *"Mustangs Pay it Forward Theme"*.
