### Intellectual Development

Goal: Improve student knowledge and skills to express themselves through writing.

#### Rationale:

We have focused on numeracy as a school for the previous 3 years and we felt it was necessary to shift our focus to literacy. After discussion and review of report cards, FSA and anecdotal teacher perspectives we decided to focus on writing.

#### Planned Actions:

3 Pro D Days with focus on identifying need, resources and strategies to support writing.  
Initiate regular "school-wide writes" to use for assessment, documentation.  
Staff provided with Adrienne Gear's resources and book "Writing Power".  
6 Staff members participating in Adrienne Gear workshop series.

#### Indicators of Success:

Student improvement in writing skills overtime based on results of "school-wide writes" report cards, and teacher perspectives.  
Increase in student opportunities and desire to communicate through writing.  
FSA results.

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## Human and Social Development

### Area of focus:

Building a sense of community and "connectedness".

### Planned Actions:

Promoting importance of thinking beyond yourself through class discussions, announcements, newsletters.

Identify vulnerable student cohorts and support with skill building and programming.

Hand project: each student identifies an action they can do to contribute to community, represent it on a hand that gets placed on tree in foyer as a visual representation.

Rock project: students identify an act that contributes to the community. When they accomplish the act they decorate a rock and add to community rock garden.

### Indicators of Success:

Student reports of examples of acts of kindness and contribution in class surveys, discussions.

Parent and staff reports of sense of community through surveys, anecdotal discussions.

Visual representations of acts of caring - Rock Garden, Community Tree.

Student Learning Survey data.

### School Community Engagement Process:

Share focus and activities with parents through newsletters, website, PAC meetings.

Parents engaged through home/school communication structures such as Freshgrade, Teams, portfolios etc.

Parents involved via home / school projects and events such as Rock Garden

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## Indigenous Learners and Indigenous Ways of Learning

### Area of focus:

Infusing Indigenous Principles of Learning into everyday practices.

### Planned Actions:

- 1) Ordered Indigenous Principles for Learning poster for each class.
- 2) Discuss each principle as a staff at Pro D Day and brainstorm ways that we practice that principle and new ways that we could do that.
- 3) Each class to replicate the above activity with students.

### Indicators of Success:

Students and staff able to identify principles and examples of how we can incorporate them into our daily routines.  
Display indicating examples of principles in hallway.

### School Community Engagement Process:

- 1) Process shared with parents through newsletters, PAC meetings, website.
- 2) Student activity involving them sharing principles and examples with parents and identifying examples in their homes.
