

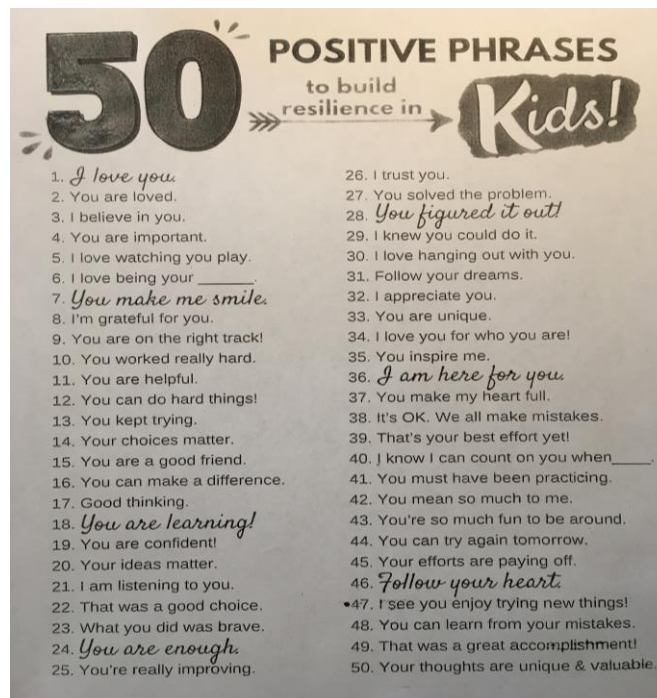

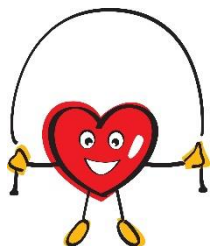

LICE AWARE

Head lice are tiny insects that live on the scalp. The best way to detect lice is to use a fine tooth comb. Anyone can get lice – it doesn't matter if your hair is clean or dirty. It is spread through direct hair to hair contact or indirect contact with use of helmets, hats, hair accessories, etc. Should a child have head lice we will make the class aware (without naming the child) and we encourage you to check your child's hair regularly.
