## Sun Run Information 2018

Congratulations for participating in one of the most popular 10km races in North America! Here are some important tips to help you plan your time in the Sun Run.

The Sun Run is very popular and very crowded, it is highly recommended that you take public transit to get to the race as much of the downtown core streets are shut down and parking is limited.

The race begins on Georgia Street, you'll see colour coded balloon archways above the street indicating the speed group (anticipated completion time). The Sun Run has a 'Wave start' meaning the various colour coded groups move down Georgia Street towards the start line. After our check-in Pitt participants need to move to their colour coded sections.

**Pitt Participants must run with a buddy or parent and will need to check in with Mme Gordon upon completing the course.**

Throughout the course there are water/Gatorade stations as well as toilets. Live entertainment is also scattered throughout the course and lots of racers dress up in costumes for the race, it's a very fun time!

The last kilometer is on the Cambie Street Bridge and ends inside BC Place Stadium. Pitt Participants will meet Mme Gordon under the letter "P" (P for Pitt River) located in the bleachers of the stadium. Please note Mme Gordon will not leave until each participant has checked in with her.

Shirts and bib numbers will be given out at school on the 19<sup>th</sup> of April, please note there is a Professional Development day on April 20<sup>th</sup>.

**Where to meet:** Corner of Beatty Street and Dunsmuir Street, just outside the **Stadium-Chinatown station** on the Skytrain Expo Line.

**What time to meet:** Between **8am** and 8:10am. We will take attendance, ensure that everyone understands where to meet at the end of the race and then will proceed to the appropriate starting area.

**Where to meet:** Inside **BC Place Stadium** under the letter "**P**"

**What time it ends:** Time dependent, usually students are finished between 10:45am and 11am.
