Secondary Remedial:

Remedial courses provide a path for students who achieved 40-49% in a course to attain a passing grade. For grade 9 courses, students will be able to upgrade their mark to 50% (C-). For grade 10 courses, students will be able to upgrade their mark to a maximum of 62% (C).

Courses: English 9, English 10, Math 9,
Math 10, Science 9, Science 10,
Social Studies 9, Social Studies 10

Students enrolled in Government Examinable courses will also be able to rewrite the provincial exam in August if they choose.

*Registration forms for remedial courses are available at all high schools and **must be signed** by a school administrator/counsellor to verify that the student is eligible to take the course(s).*

Secondary Skill Building:

These are non-credit courses designed to improve the student's level of success in (required) core courses leading to graduation.
