PARKING AND ENTRANCES:

Please review the map below indicating the drop off / pick up area for parents (lower lot unless previously arranged upper area drop off). Students please access the door relating to the floor of your classroom.

We currently have 3 entrances / exits with wash stations and/or hand sanitizer. Students are to use these three doors:

Door 1 = lower 100 level classrooms and shops

Door 2 = main floor 200 level classrooms and office
