**ATTENTION GRADE 12s:** Need a transcript? The Student Transcript Service provides Transcripts for Grade 12s who require them for scholarship and post secondary applications. This must be done in order to complete your university/college application process. This is a TWO step process with the Ministry of Education's Student Transcript Service. The first step is to register for your BCeID . The second step is to Log into the Student Transcript Service and order, view, send your transcript. All students applying to university/college must request their FINAL transcript to be shared with their post secondary institutions of choice.
