INTERNATIONAL EDUCATION SUMMER SCHOOL: International Education Summer School is now open for registration. This summer, the high school credit courses will be in an online format, with two to three weekly synchronous class sessions and two to three days a week designated tutorial support. Any Coquitlam International student wishing to take summer credit courses may only register with International Education.
