**Mounting:** The art works from all the candidates from your school must be securely mounted on one designated display board to be shipped to Coquitlam Centre. Clearly gathering and defining which area of the board is which student's art. The scholarship students' display boards from all participating schools are usually in a separate location from other school boards (TBA) displayed together for a cohesive exhibit and ease in judging. Artwork MUST NOT "fall off" or be too fragile once display is hung.

## **I. Application Criteria**

**A.** Students applying for any of the scholarships or awards must have applied for acceptance in a Visual Arts Program at a recognized Post Secondary Art Institution. The final award will not be made until the successful candidates provide proof of acceptance and fee receipts from the Institution they will be attending the following year. Awards expire 12 months from date of acceptance. The successful candidates can receive payment of the scholarship by providing the School District #43 (550 Poirer St., Coquitlam) with: letter of proof of being the successful candidate of the award, fee receipts, acceptance forms of the post-secondary institution, social insurance number, and thank you letter to donor.

**B. The Coquitlam Centre Emerging Artist Scholarships (\$500 ea.)** will go to one student from each participating secondary school. Each school may sponsor a maximum of three students for these awards. **The Hedy Pothorn Award (\$200)** will go to one female student in Coquitlam. Should they be offered **The University Women's Club Scholarships (\$750 ea.)** will go to the 'top two artist' students overall. The similar criteria and regulations apply to all awards. While judges have discretion, typically a student presented one of these awards will not be offered another of these.

## **C. Application process**

Students must include with their completed application form/envelope "\*" items:

1. \*Signature of support from a district art teacher who can attest to art experience.
2. \*300 word typed write up outlining their interest in art & career aspirations. 3 copies.
3. \*Verification of application (or acceptance) to a Visual Art Post-Secondary program.
4. A portfolio of current Artwork – maximum of **six works** as space permits.
5. Nametags **MUST:** artists full legible name, school, title, media [option: short/sentence 'write up'], attach near the (right) corner of each work [adjustable as space allows].
6. **Submit in an envelope to your Art Teacher by TBA. Application packages are collected from your teacher on TBA at Coquitlam Centre set-up.**
7. Students are responsible for mounting their works on a designated scholarship display board. They must set-up at the mall on TBA to a maximum of 9:00 pm as supervised by teacher (layout must be decided prior to arrival). There will be one shared board per school. Sculptural/3-D work may be represented by photographs from different angles. Students must take down art and display board at 7:00pm TBA.

## **II. Judging**

- A. A panel of art education specialists will form the Jury (TBA).
- B. Jurying will take place on TBA at Coquitlam Centre. (no students)
- C. Successful C. Successful recipients will be notified by telephone after the jurying.
- D. Recipients of Scholarships are expected to write a thank you letter to the contact person of the organization providing the award.
