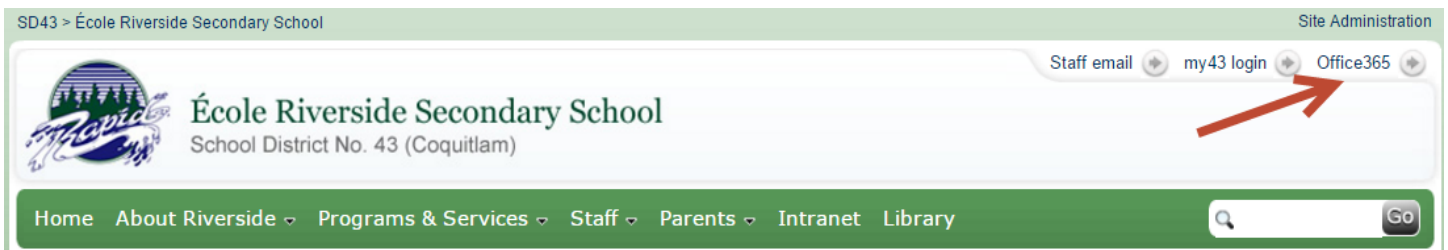


1. Visit the 1:1 Riverside website for support:

- II. To access your blog - [Click Here](#) (myriverside.sd43.bc.ca). Your username is your first name and last initial, followed by the year you entered grade 9 (e.g. Bryan Gee = bryang2016), your password is your SD43 grade 9 password.



4. Secure your device at all times! Lock up your device when you are not using it, never leave it unattended.

5. Charge your device before you come to school, and bring your charger to school. Battery packs can be borrowed from the library but they go fast.

6. If you are having troubles logging into the intranet, change your username to the following: SD43\132-username

7. Log off and turn your device off when you leave the school, turn your device on and log on every morning when you come to school.
8. Update your device with most recent updates at home!
9. Use a professional email address for professional things (for example your school district email) and create a personal email address for personal things. Make sure you create appropriate email addresses. Your SD43 email address is your first initial followed by your last name (e.g. Bryan Gee = 132-bgee@sd43.bc.ca)
10. Create a file management system for your device...learn methods to keep your work organized on your device. Bookmark the blog or website you use in each class for one-touch access.
11. **PASSWORDS!!!!** Remember your passwords, keep them in a safe location. We suggest you have one password for professional school related things, and another password for personal things.
12. Find apps and programs that work for you. Start with some key ones that work for you, start small, and then add to more once you are comfortable. For suggestions: [Click Here](#)
13. Bring a stylus pen and portable keyboard. Bring a real pen and pencil to class, not everything will be digital! Find a digi-buddy to pair up with for troubleshooting, find a person using the same device as yours in each class.
