Reflection

Overview of Our Process: There has been extensive collaboration and involvement in the development of our 2022-2023 Action Plan for Learning.

- APL Committee organized in Spring 2021 and started meeting in Fall 2022
- APL discussion added to every monthly Staff Meeting
- Parent Community was updated monthly via PAC Meetings and weekly and monthly school notices

Evidence Used (Local and Provincial)

- Classroom-Based Assessments and Class Reviews (Fall and Spring)
- FSA Results, Student Learning Survey, MDI Survey
- School-based student surveys administered at the classroom level by teachers; these were locally developed and included a Student Connection Survey (Grades K-5), an Indigenous Knowledge Survey (Grades 3-5), and an Academic Survey (Grades 3-5)

Themes that Emerged

- The majority of students felt connected to our school community, but we were able to pinpoint students who require more opportunities for connection.
- The majority of students felt they had some (vs. not much or lots) of knowledge about indigenous culture; collating the areas of knowledge, we were able to see where we need to enhance instruction as a school community.
- The majority of students found Math and Writing to be most challenging.

Conclusion: We feel we are on the right track in terms of our plans for supporting our identified goals; however, the student responses to our school-based survey will inform directions for next year's APL. We also are planning ways to increase parent engagement in our return to a more typical school context next year.
