Hello Rochester Community!

Back by popular demand, Rochester's Paper Bag Fill-up is returning for its third year! Last year, Rochester worked together to fill more than 137 paper grocery bags for families in need throughout our community during the holiday season!

So...for 4 weeks beginning Monday, November 27th until Friday, December 22nd, Mme Anderson's class and the Spirit Squad is challenging all of Rochester to see how many paper bags we can fill up with non-perishable food items, toiletries, books and toys. *This year, there will also be an option to donate money where \$25 will fill up one entire bag.* Any amount is appreciated and cheques can be made payable to SHARE. The filled bags will be lined up in our upstairs hallway for all to see. There will be a specific focus of items for each week. Below, you will find the breakdown for the 4 weeks. Please note that no one is obligated to donate items, only if it is easy and convenient!

Nov.27- Dec.1: Non-perishable food items (canned goods, packaged snacks, coffee, tea, pasta, rice, cereal etc.)

Dec.4- Dec.8: Toiletries (soap, toothpaste, toothbrushes, shampoo, toilet paper, diapers, wipes etc.) **Must be un-used items due to hygienic reasons*

Dec.11-Dec.15: Books and toys for boys and girls ages 0-12 **New, unwrapped items only please*

***Dec.18-22:** Last week for donations. Pick up by firefighters to happen Thursday or Friday.
