











SPRING BREAK DAY CAMPS THE "SCHOOL OF WONDERSTANDING" 2018

The Professional Development Program from Simon Fraser University is excited to offer four days of hands-on, action-packed activities this Spring Break from Tuesday, March 20th through Friday, March 23rd, 2018 for students from grades K-5. The four days of activities will run from 9:00 a.m. - 2:45 p.m. each day.

This unique opportunity is part of a wonderful community partnership between Simon Fraser University and School District 43. During the four days of our "School of Wonderstanding," students will participate in a number of different activities such arts and crafts, indoor/outdoor games, sports, science experiments, drama and of course- FUN. All sessions are fully supervised by student teachers in the Professional Development Program as part of their teacher training and they will be working under the supervision of certified teachers. Each session is designed to excite and delight participants with hands-on, creative learning opportunities to strengthen the connection of "wonder" and "understanding" of the world around us.

The "School of Wonderstanding" will be offered in 5 District Schools- Central Community School, Miller Park Community School, Seaview Community School, Maillard Middle School and Minnekhada Middle School. Miller Park Community School will be offering activities with some environmental and sustainability content. Seaview Community School will be offering activities with an additional focus towards arts and performing arts. Maillard Middle School incorporate traditional aboriginal cultural teachings as part of the program curriculum of this camp. Minnekhada Middle School will be only for students from <u>Grades 1 - 5 in French Immersion or Francophone Programmes</u>, and will be filled with fun French immersion or francophone program activities.

The cost for all 4 days of activities is \$60 per student, which includes supplies and materials. Participants will need to bring snacks, a bag lunch, a water bottle (with their name on it), dress comfortably and come ready to have FUN.
