This impressive total was accumulated by all students in the school! Something our community should be very proud of!

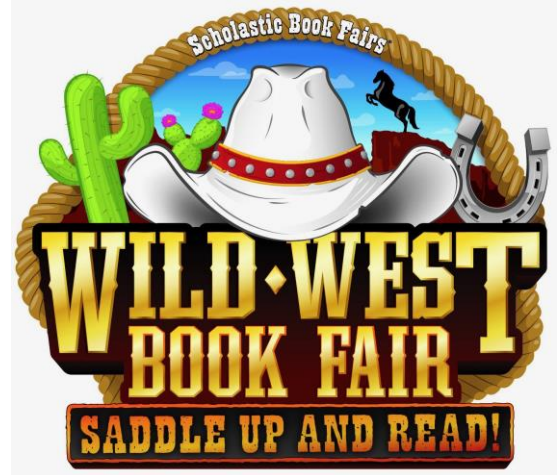
