## **Welcome Back**

I hope everyone had a wonderful summer and managed to take some time as a family to enjoy the spectacular weather we received. I am very excited about the upcoming school year. As always there will be some changes in our staff. Last June we said goodbye to the following staff members: Mrs. Burns, Ms. Calla, Mrs. Miskiman, Mrs. Pauli, and Mrs. Wyness. Mrs. Wood will also not be returning this September, but will be joining us later in the year (in April) after she completes her practicum as a school counsellor.

We have also hired several new staff members: Ms. Gajjar – Classroom Teacher, Mrs. Hide – Classroom Teacher, and Ms. Kim – Noon Hour Supervisor. We are also still working on hiring a school counsellor who will fill in for Mrs. Wood until her return in April.

This year we are adding one division to Seaview giving us 7 neighbourhood classes and 4 Montessori classes. The exact configuration of these classes is not yet finalized. After we determine our final enrollment, our staff will be working through the new class size and composition rules resulting from the Supreme Court of Canada decision that came down last year and will finalize our class configuration.

# First Week

Our first week will run in a similar way to previous years. This year, our focus will be on Self Regulation, helping our students refresh their understanding of Self Regulating their own body, Self Regulating in different environments and Self Regulating in their learning. All students will attend from 9:00 – 9:30 on Tuesday, Sep. 5<sup>th</sup>. Grade 1 – 5 students will attend full days beginning Wednesday, Sep. 6<sup>th</sup>, while our kindergarten students will progress through the gradual entry process. Our hope is to move into our regular classes on Mon., Sep. 11<sup>th</sup>, however this will be dependant on changes in our student population and our ability organize our school for the year.

On the first day of school students are asked to meet on the grass near the amphitheatre. The teachers will then meet the students, get them in their grade groups and take them to their rooms. At 9:30 the teachers will bring the students back to the front of the school to meet up with their parents again. While students are in their rooms for attendance parents are invited to join Mr. Pearse in the library for a cup of coffee, muffin, and brief welcome to the school year.

# Kindergarten Gradual Entry

On Tue. Sep. 5<sup>th</sup> Kindergarten student will be placed into one of two groups for gradual entry and schedules will be provided to parents. Each student will attend for 75 minutes on the morning of Wed, Sep. 6<sup>th</sup> and Fri, Sep. 8<sup>th</sup>, 100 minutes on Mon. Sep. 11<sup>th</sup> and then entire mornings (9:00 – 12:00) from Tue. Sep 12<sup>th</sup> – Fri. Sep. 15<sup>th</sup>. Kindergarten students will start full days at school beginning on Mon, Sep. 18<sup>th</sup>. Each family will also sign up for a 20 minute "Welcoming Conversation Time" with one of our Kindergarten teachers. These will take place during the gradual entry process.

## Do you know anyone who moved?

If you have moved over the summer or know someone who did, please drop us a quick note to let me know. To facilitate planning, it is important for us to know if your child will not be returning to Seaview this school year. Also, if new families move into the neighbourhood and ask about school registrations, they should let our school know that they will be attending right away.
