**PEACEFULLY** - the ability to behave in a peaceful and respectful way in a variety of situations and relationships.

ALERT AND ENGAGED - the ability to stay calm, focused and alert; to demonstrate self-control and to slow down and think before acting.

The Mandarin Bilingual Program in Edmonton use the YCT to assess their students' language skills.


This will be first time our Mandarin class will attempt the test.


## **COMMUNICATION SURVEY RESULT**
