We experienced some fluctuations in our enrolment last week that caused our school to reshape our classroom organizations. The first week is needed to ensure that we have an accurate headcount and that we have the appropriate levels of staffing. Although we enjoy seeing the students back with their former teachers, our staff also prefer to get the 2015-2016 school year going!

The more accurate and stable our headcount, the sooner we can move into classes. It's that simple.

Walton Elementary is among the largest, if not the largest, elementary school in the Tri-Cities. We have 542 students in our building. We are larger than seven middle schools!
