

## HEADSTART IN ART PROGRAM

Emily Carr University of Art + Design and Coquitlam School District #43 are pleased to announce the continuation of a partnership that will see ECU offer a first year studio course, taught by Emily Carr at Gleneagle Secondary School in Fall 2022.

This course will be available to current Grade 11 or 12 students or recent graduates from any of the secondary schools in School District #43 and surrounding area. The course will carry **degree credit** at Emily Carr University and transfer credit to other Fine Art programs. The course is particularly aimed at students considering post-secondary studies in visual art, media art or design.

## **FNDDT 112 Foundation Drawing Studio**

**Day & Time:** Tuesdays, 6:00-9:00pm  
**Location:** Gleneagle Secondary School  
1195 Lansdowne Drive, Coquitlam  
**Dates:** September 13th to December 13th, 2022

This course explores the fundamentals of drawing such as line, shape, tone, texture, volume, proportion, shadow, space, composition, scale, mark-making tools, and media. Exercises and projects work on perceptual and expressive drawing and hand-eye coordination. In-class projects and homework assignments will encompass various aspects of drawing while visual presentations and class discussion will introduce students to contemporary and historical ideas of art and design.



## ACADEMIC ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

This is a **UNIVERSITY LEVEL COURSE**. Students are expected to meet Emily Carr University academic admission requirements:

- English Studies 12 or English First Peoples 12 (minimum C grade)
- **PLUS** two other Grade 12 academic courses
- **PLUS** two Grade 12 electives
- Total overall grade point average in all subjects of 2.5 (C+ or 67%)

## **Applicants must provide High School Diploma Verification as confirmation that they are going to meet academic admission requirements**

*Note: Students may apply having only completed English 11; however, English 12 and Grade 12 academic and elective classes are the final requirement for future admission to Emily Carr University.*

Qualified applicants will be admitted on a first-applied basis (date of submission to your high school counsellor's office). **Space is limited to 18 seats.**
