Post Secondary Training **TUITION FREE!**



Pre-Requisites

You **must** have the following courses completed before entering the program:

- full completion of grade 11
- plan on how to complete English 12

Since you will be creating unique hairstyles for clients, it would be **suggested** to have experience in one or more of the following courses or areas:

• Art or related 'creative' course

Equipment & Costs

Tuition: Free! SD43 will cover this fee.

Student fee: approximately **\$3,000**. (textbook/guides, tools, UPass,...)

Students must supply their own **basic black clothing** and **closed-toed shoes**.

Program Schedule

This **10-month** program is taught at **VCC** (Downtown). There are **4 intake months** (September, January, March & May). Actual school days and times vary depending on the intake. Students will **not** get a Spring and/or Summer Break, depending on intake.

Program Credits

Students who successfully pass this Trades Training program will gain:

- **32 high school credits** (grade 12 level) that count towards graduation
- VCC course credits
- Level 1 technical training recognized by the Industry Training Authority (ITA) and 990 certification hours

Application Process

Go to:

www.sd43.bc.ca/CareerPrograms (select the trade) to learn more about the program and to print off an application (top link in right column).

Completed **application forms**, which include a **letter of reference** and an **updated resume**, are submitted to their **counselors**.

Applications are taken on a "**rolling basis**", meaning **students can apply any time after Sept. 1st of the current school** year for the **following school year's intake.**

The **Coquitlam coordinator and VCC department head will do separate personal interviews once a completed application is received**, Final decisions are made in mid-May but early offers of acceptance will be granted in some areas where there is strong application.

Program intake limited to 1-2 students per intake.
