

Baking and Pastry Arts Foundation Certificate High School Youth Train in Trades Program

Credits:

Program graduates receive the following:

- 24 High School Credits applied to graduation requirements
- 24 Post-Secondary Credits
 resulting in a Vancouver
 Community College transcript and
 a Baking Foundations Certificate
- Level 1 Apprenticeship Credits 600 hours technical training and 480 hours work-based training (sponsored by student's school district) towards the completion of Level 1 apprenticeship requirements.

Entrance Requirements:

To be eligible, students must have:

- Foodsafe Level 1
- Strong record of attendance and punctuality
- Grade 10 English Language Arts, Math & Science
- Written reference from teacher or counselor

Recommended Characteristics:

- Physical strength and stamina
- Ability to stand for long periods of time
- Previous baking and/or cooking experience
- Strong reading comprehension and study skills
- Time management / multitask skills
- Work independently
- Interest in working with people
- Maturity, interpersonal & communication skills
- Good hand-eye coordination

Program Schedule:

July 11 to December 15, 2022 (23 weeks)

Monday to Thursday 11:30 a.m. – 6:30 p.m.

Classes take place at the Vancouver Community College Downtown campus.

Progression and Completion:

Students must achieve 70% in each VCC course and maintain a successful attendance record to receive VCC credits and technical training certification. Students who do not meet the requirements will not be eligible to complete the program and will return to their secondary school.

Application Procedure:

- Prospective students should contact their School District Career Program Coordinator or Administrator to begin the application process.
- Applicants are required to attend a virtual information session from
 6:00 pm to 7:30 pm on Thursday,
 January 27, 2022 on Zoom (link will be provided). Parents and teachers are welcome to attend.
- Due to COVID-19, VCC is waiving the mandatory trial week. Instead, we require applicants to submit a resume and digital portfolio with their application.
- 4. Interviews: May 2 & 3, 2022

Successful applicants will be notified by their school district.

Program Costs:

Youth Train in Trades is a program funded by the Industry Training Authority of BC (ITA).

Students must check with their school or district regarding the portion of costs they are required to pay. Students are eligible for Youth Train in Trades funding.
