## Why? Pourquoi?

- To practice adding ones, tens, and hundreds
- To develop mental math strategies and make sense of quantities

## You will need: Tu auras besoin:

- 1. An appropriate starting level
- 2. Partners or groups of 3
- 3. Two ten-sided dice (ones, tens or hundreds depending on the level)
- 4. One game page per group
- 5. A bag of bingo chips per group (containing at least 19 chips)
- 6. Pencils and scrap paper or whiteboards for recording

## **Objective:**

To collect as many points as possible!

## How to Play:

- 1. Lay down one bingo chip per square on the game page.
- 2. Students take turns rolling, adding dice, collecting the bingo chip on the sum, and making note of points earned (point value matches the sum).
- 3. Lose a turn if no bingo chip is left on the sum.
- 4. Keep going until all chips are gone or the teacher says stop.
