As the third largest school district in the province, we are located within a 40-minute drive from downtown Vancouver. The school district has a population of 32,000 students with approximately 4,300 teaching, administrative, managerial and support staff.

Working under the direction of administrator/designate, the youth worker implements and promotes individualized and/or group programs in First Nations studies under the direction of the teacher.

- Completion of a two-year post-secondary education diploma in child/youth care from a recognized college/institution or
- Completion of two years of university course work in Psychology or Sociology.
