
Numeracy Assessment



Regardless of your career aspirations...

if you have/get a paying job in a trade you can receive credits toward high school graduation:

- 120 hrs working = 4 credits (up to 16 credits)
- 900+ hrs worked (by Dec 31 in the school year you turn 19) and you qualify for a \$1,000 scholarship... gave out 30+ scholarships last year
- if you later pursue that trade career, those hours count towards certification

*SFU Requirements

In addition to English 12:

For Arts: Foundations of Math 11 or Pre-Calculus Math 11 at 60% or better plus 4 more gr. 12 approved academic courses

For Sciences: Pre-Calculus Math 11 and 12; Physics 11, Chemistry 11, 3 gr. 12 Science courses

For Business: Pre-Calculus Math 11 and 12, plus 3 gr. 12 approved courses (supplementary application)

*Key Messages from SFU

- *Grade 11 and 12 course required for admission for some programs at SFU will remain specific, while other programs will have more flexible requirements.
- *SFU will look at your grades in nearly ALL your academic Gr.11 and Gr.12 courses.
- *SFU will now take a holistic approach for their admission process.

In addition to English 12:

A "Personal Profile" required for all applicants

For Arts: Foundations of Math 11 and 12 or Pre-Calc 11; plus 3 more approved academic gr 12 courses

For Sciences: Pre-Calculus Math 11 and 12; Physics 11; Chemistry 11; one gr. 12 Science; 1 more approved academic course

For Business: Pre-Calculus Math 11 and 12, 2 approved gr. 12 courses; Video Interview

Only courses with a final mark as of Feb 1st of the grade 12 year will be considered for admission. Grade 11 marks will be used in some cases where a grade 12 mark is not yet available.

*Key Messages from UBC

- * Pre-requisites and requirements are not changing. You do not have to take different/more courses than currently required.
- * You should take courses in secondary school that are related to what you want to study at UBC. Doing so will increase your chances of admission.
- * UBC will look at your grades in nearly ALL your academic Gr.11 and Gr.12 courses.
- * When we look at your overall grades, we will drop your lowest Gr.11 or Gr.12 course; so it is safe to experiment.
- * Be aware that having the highest grades is not the only way to get in challenging yourself by taking more courses or more rigorous courses can also be beneficial

General Admission Programs

(Programs such as General Studies, Business, Arts, Sciences)
Graduation

English 12 at 60% or better

Limited-Enrollment Programs (programs such as Arts, Nursing, Dental Assisting, etc.) and University Transfer

Must meet general **and** specific department admission requirements; often includes Math 11 Foundations with 60%

SFU/Douglas College Partnership Program

SFU Entrance requirements apply

Specific programs only within the Faculties of Arts and Social Sciences, Environment, Science

Can take courses at both SFU and Douglas

Riverside Honour Roll Criteria

Students must be enrolled in 8 Riverside courses (not including GT) a minimum of 4 courses within the timetable (Periods 1-5) in each semester to qualify for honour roll

**Full-time Student Course Load

In grade 12, students should take 8 courses plus GT. In special circumstances, with permission students may elect to take 7 courses plus GT (90 credit minimum required)

**If you are planning for direct entry to a university it is recommende to be enrolled in 8 classes.


