Public Interest Disclosure Act Board of Education of School District No. 43 Annual Report For the period ending June 30, 2025

The Board of Education of School District No. 43 ("School District") became subject to the *Public Interest Disclosure Act* ("PIDA") on December 1, 2023. The *PIDA* is legislation that supports ethical and accountable practices by providing a safe and legally protected way for employees and former employees of governmental bodies to report serious wrongdoing and provides them with protection against reprisals. The types of wrongdoing that can be reported under the *PIDA* include:

- A serious act or omission that constitutes an offence under an enactment in BC or Canada:
- An act or omission giving rise to a substantial and specific danger to the life, health or safety of persons, or to the environment;
- A serious misuse of public funds or public assets; and
- Gross or systemic mismanagement.

Under section 38 of the *PIDA*, the School District is responsible for issuing this annual report on the disclosures that it received under the *PIDA* within the year.
