President's welcome (Rosey Manhas)	<p>Number of volunteers is dwindling. Mery suggested that we can recruit volunteers through classroom liaisons</p>
Principal's update (Remi Collins)	<p>277 kids registered for September 2019 (next year 345 kids without any cross catchment - 110 above what the school started with)</p> <p>Kindergarten: 75, grade 1: 78, grade 4: 33, grade 5: 34</p> <p>Some outdoor ares are being added (tether ball court, log benches)</p> <p>Murals around the school (currently looking into artists). Murals will consist of individual canvases coloured by grade 5 students, as well as a group painting where each grade 5 student contributes and each year students will add to the painting (\$15 per student which school will cover this year). Artist will come on June 10 to paint with the students.</p> <p>Group of teachers and Principal Collins have been visiting other schools to learn about social emotional learning, helping students with self regulation. Looking into adding more equipments (sensory pad, stationary bike)</p> <p>Kindergarten orientation will be on May 8 5:15-6:30 (will have fewer station and longer durations)</p> <p>Sports Day will be May 17</p>

Treasurer's Report (Tanya Hassard)	<p>Some fundraising events did not happen from the budget (purdy's and plant sale)</p> <p>Year end BBQ: PAC has put a deposit for bouncy castle and the total cost will be \$1000. The cost should be covered by the sales at the BBQ</p>
Year End BBQ	<p>Year end BBQ will be on June 21 and includes hot dogs/juices/chips for purchase, bouncy castle, face painting, snow cones, cotton candy and ice cream truck (depending on availability).</p> <p>Selected Party Works and picked 3 bouncy castles for the BBQ after looking at various activities to entertain the kids and the number of estimated kids that will attend. Party Works also include liability and delivery for a minimum of \$1000.</p> <p>Booked 3 bouncy castles with deposit paid.
