Presenter: Jillian Rieder (School Counsellor)	* Shared a presentation on "Three Tiers of Support"  * Some students need different support - 3 tiers  * Individual Support: Anxiety (many types), family structure changes, grief/loss, trauma, self-regulation, impulse, social skills etc  * She's meeting with kids 1 on 1 (30 minutes): depends on what child needs  * In these sessions the student shares how they feel and what's on their mind. Chat on that. Then they move to strategy.  * In the end, they make a wish together  * Small Group Sessions: social skills, friendship groups, self regulation etc. Small groups sometimes start term 2. Often has to do with friendships and how to be a good friend.  * Class-wide: there are programs class-wide where Jillian helps the teacher and students.  * E.A.S.E: Everyday Anxiety Strategies for Educators  * Mood Meter: How your kids are feeling as a colour (red zone, blue zone etc). If you hear them speak of this at home that is where this comes from.  * Safe Bodies: Safe touch etc  * Mind Up: Doing training for this. Teaches kids about their brain and how our emotions are connected to our brain.  * Restorative circles: Teaching in a lot of circles in class.  * Works with kids if there are conflicts that happen at recess and lunch  * Student Wellness Page: Working on this and hopes it will be a resource for parents as well.  * Referral Process: Can come from parent, teacher or child.
