	<ul> <li>Lateness – Approx 50-60 kids arrive late every day</li> <li>Student needs to check in at the office if they're late. If they don't, the office calls the parent to let them know they're absent</li> <li>Same students showing up late; makes it difficult for some children who arrive late often</li> <li>Self-regulate, younger students can't sit still for long periods of time during class</li> <li>If arrive early, opportunity to go inside on bad weather days</li> <li>Walk to school day this Thursday morning - RCMP, ICBC, Speed Watch</li> </ul>
