

A Registration Guide for **SD43 Families**

School District 43 (Coquitlam) is pleased to welcome all new students to our school district and schools. SD43 (Coquitlam) provides public education for the Cities of Coquitlam, Port Coquitlam, Port Moody, and the Villages of Anmore and Belcarra.

Most students are eligible to register directly at their catchment school. You can locate your catchment (neighbourhood) school by placing your address into our school locator.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

A student is eligible to register with SD43 (Coquitlam) if:

- The custodial parent/legal guardian and student are 'ordinarily resident' in British Columbia (BC School Act Section 74(6) may limit registration eligibility).
- The student will be five years old by December 31 of the year they register.

WHEN CAN I REGISTER?

Students turning five (5) before Dec 31st in the current year, may register for Kindergarten in February of the same year.

Students moving into the district can register at any time by visiting or contacting their catchment (neighbourhood) school.

1. WHAT DOCUMENTS DO I NEED?

A. RESIDENCY

Three documents showing the custodial parent/legal guardian's name and address in British Columbia.

ONE (1) PRIMARY DOCUMENT

AND TWO (2) SECONDARY DOCUMENTS

Parent's Status in Canada **Permit Requirements**

Parent study permit

Not all study permits qualify for ministry funded education. To qualify, the custodial parent/legal guardian's study permit must be:

- One year or longer
- Enrolled in one of the following:
- Degree or diploma program at a public post-secondary institution
- Degree program only at a private post-secondary institution
- ESL program at a BC-EQA accredited school that is a pre-requisite for a degree program. ESL programs may be used for one year only

Parents must provide ALL the documents below:

- Passport
- Study permit
- Letter of Acceptance or transcript
- Statement of tuition paid for the current semester
- · Program schedule for the current semester

Parent work permit

Not all work permits qualify for ministry funded education. To qualify, the custodial parent/legal guardian's work permit must be:

- One year or longer
- Valid for a minimum of twenty (20) hours of work per week for the full duration of the work permit

Parents must provide ALL the documents below:

- Passport
- Work permit
- Proof of lawful employment for a minimum of twenty (20) hours per week shown on three (3) recent paystubs

Frequently Asked **Questions**

How is my child's eligibility for a publicly funded education determined?

Eligibility for a publicly funded education is based on the custodial parent/legal guardian and school-aged child maintaining ordinary residence in British Columbia. Even if the child is born in Canada, the custodial parent/legal guardian must be ordinarily resident in BC to qualify. Immigration status is relevant but does not determine ordinary residence.

What if I don't have all the required documents?

If you don't have all the required documents, the school will refer you to the School Board Office, located at 1080 Winslow Avenue in Coquitlam. The Board Office team will review your child's eligibility for a publicly funded education on a case-by-case basis with care and sensitivity.

I have a work permit/study permit. Is my child eligible for a publicly funded education in BC?

Some students whose custodial parents/legal guardians are temporary residents in the Coquitlam School District are eligible for a publicly funded education. Please review the Parent's Status in Canada Permit Requirements section for more information.

I am a refugee claimant/asylum seeker. Is my child eligible for a publicly funded education in BC?

Refugee claimants, asylum seekers, and refugees are eligible for a publicly funded education in BC. You can enroll your child in school while your claim/ your child's claim is being processed.

Will you report my immigration status to federal immigration authorities?

Confidentiality of personal information is protected under the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (FOIPPA). While the school district recognizes the federal government's legal jurisdiction over immigration matters, it is not the role of the school district to share immigration status information with external federal agencies unless legally ordered to do so.

I don't speak English well. Who can help me?

Coquitlam School District has a team of Settlement Workers in Schools (SWIS workers). SWIS workers provide language-based service to our new immigrant families. Our current team offers services in Cantonese, Mandarin, Farsi, Dari, Spanish, Portuguese, Russian, Korean, and Arabic.
