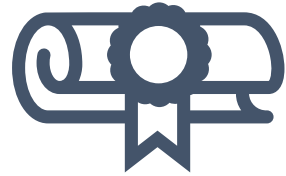

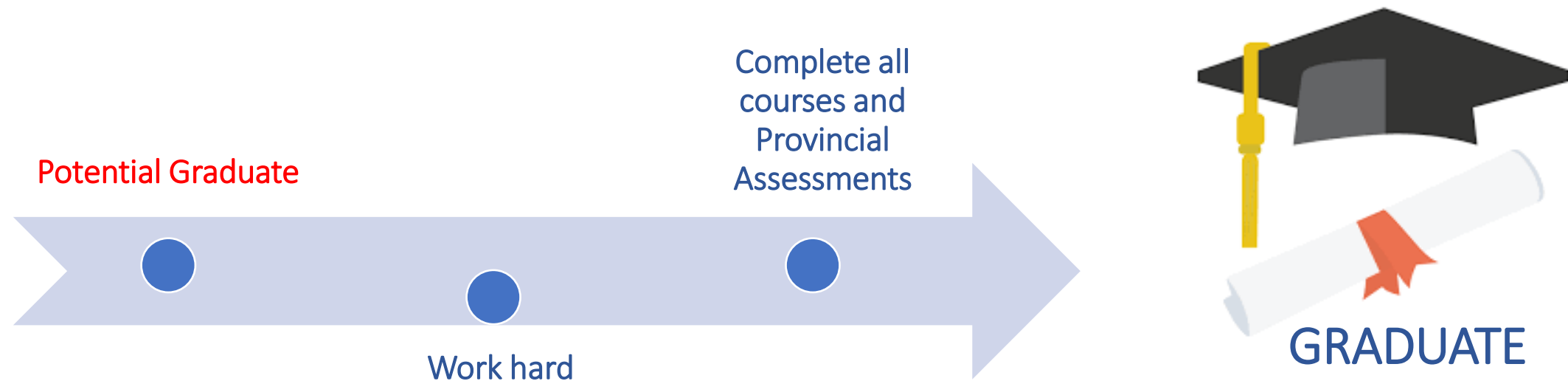

How do I move from being a **potential** grad to a **graduate** of the Class of 2022?

- Complete all courses and provincial assessments necessary in order to meet Ministry of Education requirements.



Provincial Assessments: April 27-29

- Regular classes NOT in session.

- Each half-hour, a group of up to 5 students will cross the stage one at a time with their guests present.



What will Graduation Day look like?
