- 6. Admin Report Andrew
 - Parent teacher conferences held last month
 - Lots of active clubs
 - Staff starting to prepare reports for 1st term, reports including IEP's will be on MyEd December 6



- Exciting news speed bumps being placed on drive through this Friday (pending weather), student safety remains a priority
- Staff and students in continuous discussion around literacy goal to engage students in being
 interested in reading; with technology, info is quick and short, trying to get kids to dig in deeper
 into reading
- Returning to focus on social emotional learning; during the pandemic the focus was a care model to address the added stresses and fears; now returning to goals of self-regulation, problem solving, conflict resolution
- Andrew in discussion with Diversity and Anti-Racism District Principal Wendy Wu about what EMM wants to do to have an equitable school
- If parents have questions or ideas, always welcome to come talk to Andrew

Parent question: on MyEd, can't access report cards

Andrew: reports not available after school year ends when ministry does a refresh of the system; parents can call office and ask secretary to generate a report card; parents reminded to download reports from MyEd

- 7. Co-Chair Report: Katie & Michelle
 - Set up Whats App group for exec and members at large for any quick chats; anything formal through emails
 - Rena will manage PAC emails; Jessica currently answering any Winter Market questions; Jill volunteered to check emails along with Rena
 - "Student Experience" survey for gr. 8 leaving; Andrew suggests Microsoft forms and admin can send the survey to student ie. preferences for a dance, outdoor adventure, gift, etc.
 - Andrew reports last year gr. 7 parents helped out to set up the buffet and refreshments for the meal served after the gr 8 Leaving Ceremony so gr. 8 parents could hang out with kids "paying forward"
 - Fundraising:
 - remind parents of "passive fundraising" (mention EMM when purchasing items at Cobbs, etc)
 - Miranda will prepare a graphic for social media and newsletter; deadline of Nov 15 to submit items for the newsletter to Saras in the office
 - Yerika volunteered to touch base with passive fundraisers Cobbs, Liquor Store, Recycling
 - Miranda reports that someone from "Dollars and Cents" reached out to her about a possible fundraising program for schools, she will follow up with them
 - Saras retiring on December 22 PAC to discuss a gift
- 8. DPAC Report Maria
 - Working on acquiring DPAC meeting schedule
- 9. Events
 - a. Hot Lunch Oscar
 - i. Working on getting this going, Michelle suggests goal for late November
 - ii. Will need call out to parents to help day of, managing munch-a-lunch



- b. Winter Market Jessica and Jane
 - i. Need a lot of volunteers set up, take down, managing each table, etc, currently have 13 volunteers, need closer to 50
 - ii. Event scheduled for December 13 and 14; gym available after school Dec 12 for set up
 - iii. Parents pay via School cash online
 - iv. Stephanie last year revenue \$9,620, expenses \$3,874
 - v. Discussion about food sensitivities, vegan options likely not possible within budget
 - vi. Jane requested info about process for parent reimbursement when purchasing items for the Winter market; Steph to enquire about setting up e-transfer option with the bank
 - vii. Jessica and Jane propose an increase to budget; PAC exec requests to see separate budgets for winter market and for items that can be used for other events/investment items; conversation re: potential to increase budget ongoing
 - viii. Motion to approve current spending budget for Winter Market to \$5,000 all in favour
- 10. Treasurer's Report Stephanie
 - Stephanie will talk to bank about e-transfers to ensure quick reimbursements
 - Annual budget is very similar to last year's actuals; Stephanie working on finishing budget with updates
 - BC Gaming funds received \$10,000 (plus \$3,484 carry over from last year)
 - Revenue sources include munch-a-lunch, winter market, parent donation for gr 8 leaving, passive fundraisers
 - Potential budget items:
 - EMM's 10-year anniversary; Andrew says staff are discussing an event in May 4pm-7pm open house and ceremony with an art piece
 - Kevin Keeler's work to put EMM signage on back of school
